



INVERNESS: HOW TO GET TO US

Inverness is the capital of the Highlands and easily reachable from London, Glasgow and Edinburgh by air, rail or road.

To make planning your mountain bike adventure easy, we've created this handy guide to make your arrival to Inverness, and the start of your mountain bike adventure, as easy and pain-free as possible.

London to Inverness

Distance: 443 miles

By Air - London - Inverness Airport

Average flight time: 1h 25m

Airline providers: British Airways: flying from London Heathrow Airport - www.britishairways.com, Easyjet: flying from London Luton or London Gatwick Airports - www.easyjet.com

Inverness Airport - Inverness

Inverness Airport is only a 30 minute bus or taxi journey outside the city centre.

Bus providers: Stagecoach Jet 11 service - services every 30 minutes, tickets £4 each way - www.stagecoachbus.com.

Taxi providers: Inverness Taxis - 01463 222222, City Taxis - 01463 222555, Tartan Taxis - 01463 264264

By Rail - London - Inverness Railway Station

Average travel time: 8h 30m

Train service providers: Virgin Trains East Coast - www.virgintrainseastcoast.com,

ScotRail: www.scotrail.co.uk, Caledonian Sleeper - www.sleeper.scot - Sleeper service operates an 21:15 service which will get you to Inverness by 08:38 (Monday - Saturday).

Glasgow to Inverness

Distance: 170 miles

Connections from Glasgow International Airport: First Bus provide a regular shuttle service from the airport into Glasgow city centre. Tickets from £7 - www.firstgroup.com.

By Rail - Glasgow Queen Street Station - Inverness Railway Station

Average travel time: 3h 30m

Train service providers: Scotrail - www.scotrail.co.uk - There is a regular train service between Glasgow Queen Street and Inverness, which takes approximately three and a half hours. **You may have to change trains at Perth or Stirling.**

If you are bringing your own bike you should also telephone +44 (0)8457 55 00 33 to book your bike on the train. There is no cost to take your bike on the train.

By Coach - Glasgow Buchanan Bus Station- Inverness Bus Station

Average travel time: 3h 30m

Coach service providers: Citylink Gold Service - www.citylinkgold.co.uk,
Citylink - www.citylink.co.uk

The Citylink Gold service offers a more comfortable, more spacious service than the standard Citylink service. For either service, you do not need to book your bike on to the bus.

Edinburgh to Inverness

Distance: 170 miles

Connections from Edinburgh International Airport: Lothian Buses provide a regular shuttle service from the airport into Edinburgh city centre. Tickets from £4.50 - www.lothianbuses.com.

There is a regular tram service from Edinburgh Airport into the centre of Edinburgh, which stops near the bus & train station. Tickets from £5.00 - www.edinburghtrams.com.

By Rail - Edinburgh Waverley Station - Inverness Railway Station

Average travel time: 3h 30m

Train service providers: Scotrail - www.scotrail.co.uk - There is a regular train service between Edinburgh Waverley and Inverness, which takes approximately three and a half hours. **You may have to change trains at Perth or Stirling.**

If you are bringing your own bike you should also telephone +44 (0)8457 55 00 33 to book your bike on the train. There is no cost to take your bike on the train.

By Coach - Edinburgh Bus Station - Inverness Bus Station

Average travel time: 3h 30m

Coach service providers: Citylink - www.citylink.co.uk

You do not need to book your bike on to the bus.
